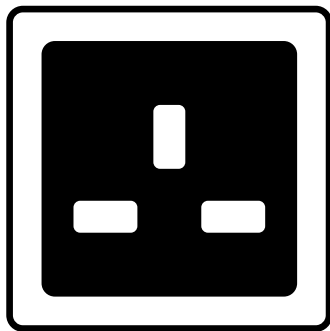
THINGS TO REMEMBER



The weather in Dublin is unpredictable. The average temperatures for July range from 12°C to 20°C. Ensure to pack some waterproofs just in case.



The local currency in Ireland is Euro. Visa and Mastercard are widely accepted throughout Ireland; American Express is accepted in some places but not all.



Ensure to bring your travel adaptors.



There is no smoking in public places only in designated smoking areas.

TRAVEL APPS TO DOWNLOAD



TFI APP

The TFI Live App allows you to access live real time departure and journey planning information across the Transport for Ireland (TFI) network.



LUAS

The Luas is similar to a tram/over ground tram. The Luas app provides live information about various lines through Dublin City and can calculate your fare between points.



IRISH RAIL

The Irish Rail App informs you when the next Dart or Train is due. The Dart operates between Greystones and Howth/Malahide. The Train operates national services throughout Ireland.



FREE NOW

The Free Now App allows you to order a taxi from your location or to book one in advance, or for a later time. Cash and Card are both accepted.



UBER

The Uber app allows you to order a car ride from your location, or to book one in advance. You can pay by cash or card. All Uber drivers are licensed.

Airport Transportation

At the end of the conference, Dublin Airport can be reached easily from Dublin city centre using either Dublin Express or Aircoach. Both services operate frequent departures throughout the day and provide direct journeys to both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2.

Aircoach

Aircoach operates frequent services from Dublin Airport to Dublin city centre, destinations across County Dublin, and a number of locations throughout Northern Ireland. Coaches depart from Terminal 1 (Zone 2) and Terminal 2 (Zone 20).

For delegates travelling to and from Trinity Business School, Route 700 is the most convenient service. The nearest stop to the conference venue is Westmoreland Street, Dublin City Centre, which is approximately a 10-minute walk from Trinity Business School.

Dublin Express

Dublin Express offers one of the fastest and most frequent coach services between Dublin Airport and Dublin city centre. Coaches feature free onboard Wi-Fi, USB charging ports, and generous luggage space, providing a comfortable and convenient journey.

Services depart from directly outside the arrivals halls at Terminal 1 and Terminal 2, with departures as frequently as every 7½ minutes during peak periods.

For delegates travelling to and from Trinity Business School, Route 784 is the most convenient service. The nearest stop to the conference venue is Trinity College (College Green/Temple Bar), Stop 7588.

The Book of kells Tour

The Book of Kells Experience offers a guided or self-guided tour of Trinity College Dublin, including the Old Library, the Long Room, and a close-up view of the 9th-century illuminated manuscript.

Trinity Trails

Guinness Storehouse
